NOTE NO. 1: SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

1) Accounting Convention:

The Financial Statement have been prepared under the historical cost convention on the accrual basis of accounting and in accordance with the requirement of accounting Standards prescribed by the Companies (Accounting Standards) Rule, 2006 and the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 to the extent applicable.

2) Use of Estimate:

The preparation of financial statements requires the management of the Company to make certain estimates and assumptions that affect the reported balances of assets and liabilities and disclosures relating to the contingent liabilities as at the date of the financial statements and reported amounts of income and expenditure for the year. Actual results may differ from those estimates. Any revision to such estimates is recognised prospectively.

3) Inventories:

Finished goods and work-in-Progress are valued at lower of the cost including related overheads or estimated net realisable value.

4) Revenue Recognition:

The Company generally follows the mercantile system of accounting and recognises income and expenditure on an accrual basis except those with significant uncertainties.

Dividend, interest and other income are accounted on accrual basis except those items with significant uncertainties.

5) Taxation:

- (i) Provision for current tax is made on the assessable income computed for the accounting period in accordance with the income Tax Act, 1961.
- (ii) Deferred tax is recognised, subject to the consideration of prudence, on timing differences, calculated by applying tax rates and tax laws that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the balance sheet date. Deferred tax assets arising mainly on account of business losses and capital losses under tax laws are recognised, only if there is a virtual certainty of its realization, supported by convincing evidence. At each balance sheet date,



the carrying amount of deferred tax assets is reviewed to reassure realization.

6) Cash and Cash Equivalents:.

Cash flow are reported/using the indirect method, where by net profit before tax is adjusted for the effects of transaction of a non cash nature and any deferrals or accruals of past or future cash receipts or payments. The cash flow comprises regular revenue generating, investing and financing activities of the company. Cash and cash equivalents in the Balance sheet comprise of cash at bank and in hand and short term, highly liquid investments that are readily convertible into known amounts of cash and which are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in the value.

7) Provisions:

A provision is recognised when an enterprise has a present obligation as a result of past event and it is probable that an outflow of resources will be required to settle the obligation, in respect of which a reliable estimate can be made. Provisions are not discounted to its present value and are determined based on best estimate required to settle the obligation at the Balance sheet date.
